Dear Friends,

First of all my apologies for the lateness of this newsletter!

Last week I was in the United States for a funeral from one of my relatives. I had hoped to do the newsletter from there, but I had problems with the internet and with my cell phone.

Now that I am back in good old Germany, my focus is back on what God is doing in our land. Everywhere I go, the prophets are saying that a revival is coming to Germany. There is a new wind blowing in our land, the wind of the Holy Spirit!

With only seven weeks to our 30-year church anniversary and outreach, there is excitement in the air.

The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit." (John 3:8)

Let us get in the flow and continue to allow the Holy Spirit to move us forward – inside and outside. The Kingdom of God is unstoppable.
