Dear Friends,

I found this article from Rhema Germany to be very helpful. We also have been talking about this subject in the young adults group. Please take the time to read this.

The Holy Spirit will lead, guide, and direct you in the way you should go. He wants to give you "inside" information.

Acts 27:9-13 NKJV

9 Now when much time had been spent, and sailing was now dangerous because the Fast was already over, Paul advised them, 10 saying, "Men, I PERCEIVE that this voyage will end with disaster and much loss, not only of the cargo and ship, but also our lives." 11 Nevertheless the centurion was more persuaded by the helmsman and the owner of the ship than by the things spoken by Paul. 12 And because the harbor was not suitable to winter in, the majority advised to set sail from there also, if by any means they could reach Phoenix, a harbor of Crete opening toward the southwest and northwest, and winter there.13 When the south wind blew soft, supposing that they had obtained their desire, putting out to sea, they sailed close by Crete.

It was a dangerous time of storms, and Paul said something interesting. He said, "I perceive this voyage will end with disaster." **Perceive** means to 'become aware of through the senses or to become conscious of'. Paul had a perception. He became aware that they were going to experience trouble. The Holy Spirit witnessed to Paul that the voyage would have some trouble.

Romans 8:16 NKJV

The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.

The Holy Spirit witnesses to our spirit not with a loud voice or a "shout", but a perception. In other words, by a sensing or knowing in our spirit. We are not to look for something on the outside of us to tell us the direction to go. Some will say, "If God is bearing witness with my spirit, then why am I not perceiving things in the same way Paul did in Acts 27?"

Many times, we are too busy with our body and our mind. We have conditioned ourselves to be busy all the time. This is why quiet time is so valuable. We need to learn to be quiet before the Lord and put our mind to rest. Praying in the spirit helps you to do this. When you get quiet before the Lord, you can sense what the Lord is witnessing to your heart. We need to tune in to hear what He is saying. He's talking. We just need to tune in.

Open your mouth and say, "Lord, you love me. I am your sheep, and I hear your voice. I thank you for that." If you will thank Him ahead of time, you will begin to hear His voice in your spirit. Practice being quiet before the Lord for a few minutes every day. - No screen, no noise ... just quiet. It is a good discipline to help you tune in to the Holy Spirit. The more conscious we become of the fact that we are a spirit, have a soul, and live in a body, the easier it is for us to understand that our spirit is where the Lord enlightens us.
