Dear Friends,

Wintery greetings to everyone! I hope that you are enjoying the advent season, and that you will have some special times with your family and friends this month.



About a year ago, I began to obey some special instructions that God gave me at the BFP conference in Willingen (Upland). When we obey God and do what He says, there are some important things that we must remember:

- 1) True obedience requires a **timely response**. Just like when we who are parents expect our children to do something there is an expectation about when we want to see them in motion. If we ask our children to set the table, it is understood that the food is almost ready to be served. The plates and silverware should be moving from the kitchen to the dining table within the next few minutes. Often people say that they want to obey God, but do not respond **when** He is wanting them to.
- 2) True obedience is something we do even when we don't see immediate results. Too many obey in the beginning but give up when it looks like there is no fruit. All successful people know that anything worth doing requires time and effort. There will also be spiritual opposition to the things that God is wanting carried out. We need to know in advance that true obedience involves continuing to do what God has said until He says stop!
- 3) True obedience is a **personal commitment**. Just because others quit the team does not mean that you should also stop what you are doing. The often-sung song, "I have decided to follow Jesus", includes the verse that says, "Though none go with me, still I will follow...". At the end of the day, I must answer the question, "What did God ask me to do?".

What others are doing or not doing has no relevance when it comes to my obedience. I must lead the way and get personally involved — **obedience cannot be delegated.**

4) True obedience requires a **proper attitude**. Just like God loves a "cheerful giver", He also loves it when we do things out of a heart of love. I truly do not think that God gets any satisfaction out of watching His children do things with a stinking attitude. I know that I don't want anyone doing anything for me while complaining. In God's house, we serve with gladness! It is an honor to be chosen by Him for a special task.

Well maybe you are wondering what it is that God asked me to do. He asked me to focus the rest of my years – my best years – on reaching out to the next generation. This is also the mandate He gave me to pass along to our church. We can focus on many things, but I believe that if we fail at this, we have failed at the most important thing that is on His heart.

I continue to focus myself and to emphasize this to our church family. One thing that can help us is to listen to the videos of the BFP conference from last year. If these messages do not grab your heart, then I do not know what will.
